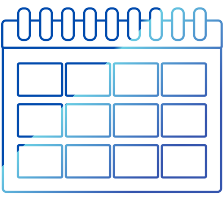


DISTANCE LEARNING MODEL

Special education services will be provided throughout the day per student's IEP.

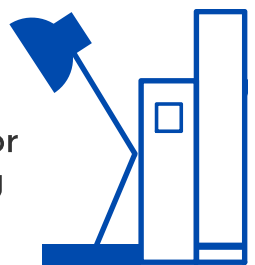


ATTENDANCE

ATTENDANCE will be taken daily during live sessions. Students can also be marked present by turning in an assignments or making contact with their teacher.

ACADEMICS AND GRADING

DaVinci Academy teachers will continue to utilize the rigorous curriculum adopted K-8 including Core Knowledge and Singapore Math (Math in Focus) for grades K-5. Grading for **K-5** will be based on student progress towards meeting MN State Standards Assessments. Grading **6-8** will be letter grades. Assessments will take place virtually.



COMMUNICATION

Communication will be streamlined K-8

Bloomz All teachers will use Bloomz to communicate with families.

Communication will go out by 4pm Fridays outlining assignments, schedule, topics, and events for the upcoming week.

Infinite Campus will be used to record attendance and grades.

Clever will be used to save passwords and logins so students and families only have to login once to access all their saved sites.

Google Classroom will be used to post and turn in assignments. All Google Classrooms will be set up in a consistent manner.

TECHNOLOGY

Chromebooks will be issued to all students in grades 3-8 for use at home. Chromebooks will be distributed to students in grades K-2 as needed.



SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

There will be an intentional focus on building community in classes through in person and virtual platforms. There will be mini-lessons during morning meeting and advisory and monthly workshops led by the counseling team.

One on one and group counseling is available.

We will continue to utilize PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) and SPARK.
