Ways to Find a COVID-19 Vaccine

COVID-19 vaccine is widely available. There are many options for places to get a vaccine. Here are some different ways to find a COVID-19 vaccine.

Where to look

- Search for COVID-19 vaccine providers: Find Vaccine Locations (mn.gov/covid19/vaccine/find-vaccine/locations/index.jsp).
 - Pharmacies. Local and national chains are vaccinating people.
 - Health care systems/clinics. At many places, you do not need to be a patient to get vaccinated there.
- Find COVID-19 vaccines near you on Vaccines.gov. You can sort by vaccine product.
- Sign up for an appointment at a state community vaccination site or walk in. Learn more at <u>COVID-19</u> <u>Community Vaccination Program (mn.gov/covid19/vaccine/find-vaccine/community-vaccination-program/index.jsp)</u>.
- Find clinics through local public health departments at Minnesota: Find a Vaccination Clinic (prepmod.health.state.mn.us/clinic/search).
- Watch for community vaccination events. Local events at schools, churches, and other organizations in your area may offer opportunities to get vaccinated.

Tips for getting a vaccine

- Check if a site accepts walk-ins. Many COVID-19 vaccine clinics offer walk-in options.
- Stay up to date on social media. Many sites will post when they are hosting vaccination clinics on social media. Apps and social media sites might offer a way to make an appointment.
- If you need a specific vaccine brand, call your clinic, pharmacy, health system, or look online to see what brand they have for their vaccination clinics.

Even after vaccination, take steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19 by wearing a mask and staying 6 feet away from others in public spaces, when recommended.
