6.1. Special Education Presentation Wilmot 20 minutes Overview of the Special Education department at DaVinci by Special Education Director, Amanda Wilmot. Special Education services during distance learning.

- Different services offered at school. 37 staff members are part of the Special Education
- SIT A and B two different processes to define when students qualify for services.
- 93% of the students receive services outside the classroom less than 21% outside the classroom.
- 4% of the students receive services outside the classroom between 21% and 63% of their time at
- 3% of the students receive services outside the classroom more than 63% of their time at school.



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- About 120 students qualify for special education services. It's about 14% of the student population. That is the same percentage of the state average of student receiving services.
- Special Education during distance learning: through an online platform. Students are still seeing the services providers, teachers, paras, etc. We are continuing evaluations and IEPs.
