Transportation & Busing

This summer we re-evaluated our bus stops to check for the following:

Are they fully meeting the needs of as many students as possible by being centrally located?

Are they located in areas where families can park their cars to wait for the bus?

Are we staying true to the original design of our transportation program by offering only satellite stops and not door to door busing?

What we found was that we needed to move some stops in order to affirmatively answer those questions as much as possible. So, with the help of our bus service provider, we have updated our bus stops and routes for the 2016-17 school year. We have located them all on a Google map so that families can more easily find the stop closest to them. Here is the link to the <u>Bus Route Map</u> (Bus stops are not published on the website. **Link disabled**, contact the school office for information).

Action Required - Registration Envelope Arriving by Mail

Your local postal worker will soon be delivering an important envelope to your home. It will include the following documents:

- Silent Dismissal instructions and dashboard identification tags - prior to Monday, August 8, ALL families must set transportation specifications (bus riders and parent pickup/carpool).
- Online Registration instructions, including Infinite Campus Parent Portal access key and instructions. In order to complete back to school registration and to have access to your student's online information, you must set up a parent portal account on Infinite Campus. This replaces both Powerschool and K12Online.
- School Picture form school picture day is Friday, August 12
- Fee Envelope please complete the outside of the envelope according to the instructions provided and return all fees to school at the Open House (8/4) or the first day of school

It is critical that all families (new and returning) complete the back to school registration process. This allows families the chance to:

- review and update all student, parent and emergency contact and medical information
- review important school policies and procedures
- review and update transportation elections
- plus receive other important documents and details
