Intersession classes run from 8:00 am - 3:00 pm Tuesday, January 3rd-Friday, January 6th. There will be regular busing offered as well as school lunch served. Because there are a number of field trips planned each day, teachers will let you know which days you will need to provide a bag lunch and which days your child's class will be at school for lunch time.

Registrations for January Intersession are due by 5:00 FRIDAY, DECEMBER 16th. Because of the number of field trips that need to be planned before the holiday break we will be strict about holding to this deadline. Thank you for getting your enrollment in early!

For those who sign up for Intersession, you will indicate on the registration form if you want to order school lunch for days that your student will not be on a field trip. A separate email will be sent to order lunches just for that week. It will NOT be on the regular lunch order program.


Fund Your Playground!

Snow Days & Food Service

For any day that school is cancelled, we will serve the meal planned for that day on the following day. The following days meals will then be skipped entirely for that week.

For example, if school is cancelled on Tuesday and the meal options ordered for that day were a hamburger, turkey sandwich or veggie patty, those options will be served on Wednesday instead. Wednesday meal options would be skipped entirely that week. Those students who ordered meals for Wednesday will be served one of Tuesdays meal options (hot meal, cold sandwich or vegetarian meal) but not necessarily the meal type they ordered for Wednesday. A peanut butter and jelly sandwich will always be available on these days if a student does not want what is available.

The same process will be followed for breakfast. Tuesday's breakfast will be served to those students who ordered breakfast for Wednesday.

Please keep in mind, menu items are subject to change up to and including the day of service without notice to parents or students. This happens rarely but, in case of a cancelled day, you can guarantee the day's menu will be different. Please help prepare your child for this when it happens.


