Finishing touches are being added throughout the school.


The construction crews are here after school and on weekends and we maintain the safety of the students as our first priority. That may slow down a building project or two, but will remain our primary concern until this project if final.

Drop Off & Pick Up - ACTION REQUIRED

Thank you for your patience as we have been maneuvering in our new parking lot to find the most efficient and safe experience for the busiest times of the day. Finishing up the turn lane on Jefferson will be an enormous help so that we can be good neighbors and not clog up the access on that busy road. Until then, please follow these tips to keep cars from piling up at the entrance.

- 1. Use **BOTH** north bound parking lot lanes in order to merge into the pick up and drop off curb.
- 2. Take a right out of the parking lot onto Jefferson to keep that intersection safe.
- 3. Ideal arrival time in the morning is 7:35-7:40 a.m. and Ideal pick up time in the afternoon is after 3:05 p.m.
- 4. We will need to go to a staggered dismissal system if 250 parents continue to enter the parking lot between 2:45 and 3:00. PLEASE come after 3:05 so that we can get students safely to your cars. With so many people in the parking lot we are focusing more of our energy on getting cars through efficiently and we want to be focusing more of our energy on getting your child safely to you. You have plenty of time to pick up your child after school and they are being well cared for by their teachers while they are waiting. Please reference the updated map (click to enlarge) for precise parking procedures.



Lastly, remember to update you Silent Dismissal account WELL before the end of the day to insure your information gets to the teacher accurately. If you have questions or need assistance please contact Nicole Hartfield.

Volunteer Background Checks

Are you one of our awesome DaVinci Academy volunteers or would you like to be a volunteer?

Has it been two years or more since you completed a background check consent form?

If so, a background check consent form will need to be completed and turned into the school office along with payment of \$10.

As appropriate for the protection of our students, volunteers who have contact with students will be asked to submit to and successfully complete a background check every two years, at their own expense. If you cannot afford the processing fee at this time, do not let that stop you from volunteering, contact Ms. Lach to discuss.

Below you will find a copy of the criminal background check consent form. You may also find the form on the DaVinci Academy web site under the volunteering tab, pick one up at the back to school event on August 10th or at the school office at anytime.

Once we have your completed form and payment, you will be able to sign into the Helpcounter computer terminal and begin volunteering!
