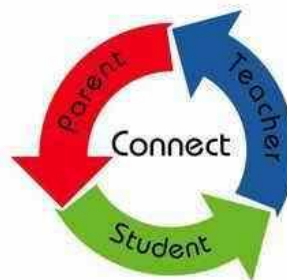
Fall Conferences - October 16 & 17

We will be holding parent/teacher conferences on Monday October 16 from 12-8 p.m. and Tuesday, October 17 from 8-4 p.m. There is no school for students those days.

Here is what you need to know:

Teachers in grades K-5 will have their conference schedule on Bloomz. They will be 15 minute conferences with a 5 minute break in between.



Most of the teachers have already made that conference schedule available to parents, so watch for emails from your teacher.

Teachers in grades 6-8 and specialists will be holding drop in conferences. For specialist teachers, you can come in any time from 12-8 p.m. on Monday and 8-4 p.m. on Tuesday. For middle school core teachers, you will want to avoid the hours of 5-6:30 p.m. on Monday and 9-10:15 a.m. on Tuesday. Those hours are reserved for teacher-requested group conferences.

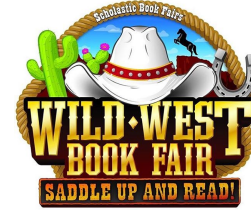

Outdoor Attire Reminder

At this time of year, the temperature outside can really fluctuate. I have listed below what students should be wearing outside during recess depending on the temperature.

If there is snow on the playground/field and students want to play in it, all students need to wear snow pants and winter boots. If they do not have snow pants and winter boots, they will need to stay on the sidewalk.

- 60 degrees or higher - short/long sleeve shirts
- 46 to 59 degrees - light jacket/hooded sweatshirts
- 45 degrees or lower - winter coat, hats and gloves
- Snow pants and boots required when there is snow

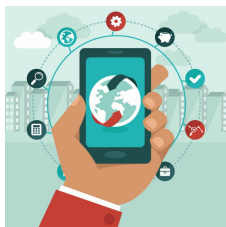
