

NEED TO KNOW.....

Being On Time

Students are on time for school when they are in their classrooms at 8:00 a.m. - not walking into the building at 8:00 a.m. Teachers are ready to start class at 8:00 a.m. so students need to be dropped



off with enough time for them to get to their rooms and get settled. Regardless of whether a staff member lets your child in at the east door or not, if a child enters the school after 8:00 a.m. they will be asked to bring a tardy slip to their classroom teacher.

If your child(ren) plans to eat breakfast at school, please have them to school by 7:45 a.m. That will give them 10 minutes to eat and 5 minutes to get to class.

If your your child is arriving late, you need to sign them into the office.

We are now accepting applications for the 2018-19 school year for students who would like to attend DaVinci


Academy for grades Kindergarten through 8th grade.

Outdoor Attire Reminder

At this time of year, the temperature outside can really fluctuate. I have listed below what students should be wearing outside during recess depending on the temperature.

If there is snow on the playground/field and students want to play in it, all students need to wear snow pants and winter boots. If they do not have snow pants and winter boots, they will need to stay on the sidewalk.



- 60 degrees or higher short/long sleeve shirts
- 46 to 59 degrees light jacket/hooded sweatshirts
- 45 degrees or lower winter coat, hats and gloves
- Snow pants and boots required when there is snow
