

Stopping for Buses

Every morning at 7:45 a.m. a K Jefferson just outside our parking lot entrance, to pick up a child. More often than not, there is a driver who does not heed the bus's stop signal and drives through it,

causing the bus driver to honk. This is just a reminder that in accordance with MN Statute 169.444 when a school bus is stopped and is displaying an "extended stop-signal arm and flashing red lights", every driver must stop their vehicle at least 20-feet away from the school bus. This is a very busy intersection that requires everyone's full attention in the morning. Your help keeping that intersection safe for all is appreciated.

Intersession - What Is It?

May 21st-24th is our Spring Intersession. It is completely optional for students to participate, and students who don't sign up for a class will have that time off school.

- Intersession classes run from 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. and are fee based classes.
- Most classes cost \$100.00 and this fee includes any field trip costs.
- Students may bring their own lunches, order bag lunches from the kitchen or eat an included lunch on certain field trips.
- Buses will continue to run as scheduled and the DaVinci Den will be open for those families currently enrolled.
- Most classes are mixed age classes and have a minimum student count in order to offer the class. We ask families to make a first and second choice when registering.
- There are some classes that have a maximum student count, so it is important to register right away before those spots get filled and the class is closed to additional children.
- Here is a sneak peek at the classes being offered: Nature Camp, Athletes and Artists, Jump, Slither and Slide, YMCA Camp, Farm Life and Planting, Physical Fun, Let's Make Golf Great Again, Reach For New Heights, Camp Adventure, Dora the Explorer Kindergarten Adventure and The Three Bears Shadow Show.
