Make picture day easy with these tips from LifeTouch:

- Choose clothing with solid colors or simple patterns
- Small jewelry and accessories are fine, but nothing too big or distracting
- Choose a background before you choose your outfit
- Avoid clothing with slogans or logos

Students will be permitted to wear non-uniform clothing to school on picture day. Clothing should be modest; no tank tops, spaghetti straps, or short skirts or short shorts, etc. Shirts should not have inappropriate writing/words and no hats are allowed to be worn in school. Hats, however, may be worn for the picture and then returned to a locker. This is the only day spring pictures will be taken. There will not be a make-up or retake option.
