Back To School Registration Is Open and <u>Required for All Students</u>

All families must go online to complete or update information for the new school year.

To access the online registration program, go to the DaVinci Academy homepage or use this link: https://secure.k12online.us/davinci-academy-of-arts-and-science

Online registration is completed through K-12 Online™. This is a school management software program that streamlines new student enrollment and simplifies returning student registration and updates information in Power School.

Note for students new to DaVinci Academy, although you may have recently completed the online enrollment through K12Online.com, you are still required to complete the online back to school registration process.

To begin the registration process, you will need a login and access code for at least one of your children. You will be able to access all siblings from one account.

Your child's login and access codes are as follows: Login ID - student's last name

Access - student's birthdate (you will need to enter the "/" and no leading "0". For example, 2/1/2001 NOT 02/01/01, 02/01/2001, or 212001)

The registration process allows you to update any personal and emergency contact data, provide current medical information, review and acknowledge select school policies and obtain other important back to school notices.

Once you complete all forms, please print, sign and return the Registration Form. You should be able to complete the entire

Lunch Program Reminders & Changes

This article highlights important reminders and changes to the school lunch program. To find out more information or to apply for Free or Reduced price meals, please use the <u>Food & Nutrition Info</u> link to go to our website.

Lunch prices for the 2015-2016 school year

- Lunch (including milk): Full Pay Students = \$3.50; Free/Reduced Program = \$0.00
- A La Carte Items (charged to ALL students): Milk alone = \$0.50; Extra slice of pizza = \$1.50, Emergency meals = \$3.50

Pre-ordering lunches

 DaVinci Academy provides school lunches through an outside vendor; we do not prepare meals on-site. In order to do this most efficiently, all families are required to preorder school through an online ordering program. You

- should receive a separate email with a personal family link by 5pm on Monday July 27. This link allows you to order lunch for each student in your family. If you do not receive this email, please contact <u>Lee. Swearingen</u>. Newer families may need to complete a paper order form until their online lunch order account is established.
- Our new vendor accepts weekly orders instead of requiring one monthly order. Therefore, if you miss the stated monthly deadline you may still be able or order meals for the later weeks. Once you receive your order email with the family link, use that any time in the future to order or change meals throughout the month. As long as you can submit an order for a day, it will be accepted by us. However, please remember that if you don't order for a particular day, you will need to send a lunch from home.

Emergency meals

 If your child forgets to bring a lunch from home and you had not pre-ordered a meal for that day, they will be provided with an emergency meal. The emergency meal consists of the fruits and vegetables on the menu for the day, a Smuckers Crustable sandwich (PB&J) and a carton of milk. The charge for this will now be the same as a regular meal. If your child has a food allergy to peanuts, we will have an alternative sandwich available.

Vegetarian meals

- We had a great response to the vegetarian meals that were offered in June. Over 230 vegetarian meals were order in just 12 days.
- As indicated previously, there is an additional cost for vegetarian meals. The cost per vegetarian meal will be \$4.50; students who receive free or reduced-price meals will be charged accordingly.
- In order to provide these meals we must update our accounting software. Therefore, there will be a <u>delay</u> before we can offer vegetarian meals again. Continue to look for information!



Please Label All Apparel

Please label <u>all</u> apparel and items sent to school; this greatly improves the chances that misplaced items are returned to your student. Hundreds of items are discarded or donated every year because they are unlabeled and remain unclaimed for an extended period of time.

a. Label all coats, hats, gloves, snow pants, boots, lunch boxes, water bottles, etc. Do NOT label school supplies unless instructed to do so on the supply list.

b. Consider using pre-made labels such as <u>Name Bubbles</u>; they are dishwasher and laundry safe. Use code DAAS15 and 20% of your order will be donated to our school!
