Norovirus Diagnosis

We have had one child diagnosed with the Norovirus. Norovirus is a very contagious virus. You can get norovirus from an infected person, contaminated food or water, or by touching contaminated surfaces. The virus causes your stomach or intestines or both to get inflamed (acute gastroenteritis). This leads you to have stomach pain, nausea, and diarrhea and to throw up. The most common symptoms of norovirus are: diarrhea, throwing up, nausea, stomach pain. Other symptoms include fever, headache and body aches. If your child is experiencing any of these symptoms, please get them checked out by the doctor as soon as possible. If they are diagnosed with norovirus, keep them home until there are no more symptoms and notify the school.
