View Lunch Transactions and Make Payments Online!

Starting immediately, you are now able to view lunch transactions, set payment reminders and fund your students' food service account using a credit card or ACH check transfers with SchoolPaymentPortal.com!

Associated fees - Parents/guardians choosing to use this service will pay a small transaction fee for each deposit made into their child's food service account using either a credit card or a bank account transfer. Those parents/guardians who do not wish to incur additional fees may continue to fund their children's meal account by delivering a check or cash to the school office.

- Credit Card Payments (Visa, MaterCard, Discover only) 2.3% + \$1.00 per transaction
- ACH Payments (Transfer directly from your bank account) -\$1.00 per transaction

Example - Parent/Guardian deposits \$50

- Credit Card Payment: The parent/guardian would be charged the \$50 that is deposited to the school bank account as well as a \$2.15 convenience fee (\$1.15 + \$1.00) paid to the online processor to cover related expenses; total transaction of \$52.15 is charged to their credit card.
- ACH Payment: The parent would be charged the \$50 that is deposited to the school bank account as well as a \$1.00 convenience fee paid to the online processor to cover related expenses; total transaction of \$51.00 is charged to their bank account.

You can process online deposits for multiple students with one transaction thereby reducing your transaction fees.

At this time, online processing is only available for deposits related to the school nutrition program (breakfast and lunch payments). We anticipate, however, that we will begin accepting activity fees before the end of this school year.

Pilot Breakfast Program Starting January 11

DaVinci Academy will be pilot testing a cold breakfast option starting January 11. Please read below for program details:

- Parents will be required to pre-order a meal for their child in the same manner as lunch. You will receive one email order link for breakfast and a <u>separate</u> email order link for lunch.
- If you do not want to receive the breakfast order link, you can asked to be removed from the email list.
- If you previously removed your email for lunch ordering, but you would like to order breakfast, you must email <u>Lee</u>
 <u>Swearingen</u> to be added to the breakfast email list.
- Only students who have pre-ordered the breakfast meal will receive the breakfast meal. Emergency breakfast meals will NOT be available.
- Students will pick up and eat breakfast in their homerooms sometime before 9:00 a.m.
- The pilot program will be run from January 11 to February 29. At the end of February, the program will be evaluated based on participation and cost. It will be decided at that time if the price needs to be adjusted or if the program has enough participation to continue.

Enrollment for the 2016-2017 School Year

Our Open Application Period for new students is coming up soon. Please note: current students do <u>not</u> need to re-apply.

Starting January 1st, we will be accepting Student Applications for the 2016-17 school year. All applications will need to be received by the school office no later than January 31. If you have a sibling who is not currently enrolled a Student Application (click here) must be completed. All completed applications will then be included in the enrollment lottery.

To enroll for kindergarten a student must be 5 years old by September 1, 2016.

Share with your friends or neighbors that we will be accepting applications for the 2016-17 school year for kindergarten through 8th grade. All Student Applications must be submitted by January 31 to be included in the enrollment lottery on February 23. Our next information session is December 17 at 6:00 pm.

DNR Fire Arms Safety Class

The DNR will be offering a fire arms safety class here at DaVinci

Academy. It includes 12 hours of classroom instruction and 5 hours of shooting practice at the range. Parents are encouraged to join their child - ages 11 and up - for the class.

It will be 2 evenings a week, probably in February. We can schedule the instructors once we have an indication of how many interested students we have. The DNR charges \$7.50 for the certification at the completion of the classes and Field Day practice.
