Silent Dismissal Working Well

On Monday March 21st, we began using our new end of day release program called Silent Dismissal. If you haven't already done so, it is imperative that you review and confirm your child's information.

Overall, the transition to the new system has gone well. Using Silent Dismissal to call the students (rather than the walkie-talkie system we previously used) has improved our end of day dismissal in the following ways:

- Entering the family numbers instead of first and last names of each student means that student get notified faster. The student is sees only their name and not their number.
- We have many families that have the same or similar last name. Using the family number ensures that only the correct students are called. No more misunderstood or misspelled names leading to confusion about which child should be called.

Please remember, regardless of how your child gets home each night, every family has steps to take. See the attached <u>instructions</u> for on setting up and changing your parent account.



Make picture day easy with these tips from LifeTouch:

- Choose clothing with solid colors or simple patterns
- Avoid clothing with slogans or logos
- Long-sleeve shirts are best

Students will be permitted to wear non-uniform clothing to school on picture day. Clothing should be modest; no tank tops, spaghetti straps, or short skirts or short shorts, etc. Shirts should not have inappropriate writing/words and no hats are allowed to be worn in school. Hats, however, may be worn for the picture and then returned to their locker. This is the only day spring pictures will be taken; there will not be a make-up or retake option.

When is the concert?

Our spring band/orchestra concert is on Thursday, May 19th. 5th and 6th grade students will perform starting at 5:00 pm. 7th, 8th, Jazz Band, and Chamber Orchestra will start at 7:00 pm.

How long will my child need to stay?

All students will be expected to stay for the entire concert in order to complete a listening assignment of the other groups performing. This will count as half of their concert participation score.

What is the dress code?

5th and 6th grade will wear white dress tops (boys need a button up shirt) and black dress bottoms with black dress shoes.

7th and 8th grade will wear ALL BLACK with black dress shoes. Boys need a black button up shirt. Girls need long skirts or dress pants. Leggings/yoga pants are NOT acceptable.

How will I help at home?

Our musicians need to learn their music at home. Rehearsals are used for learning everything that's happening around them. We cannot use rehearsal time to only figure out individual parts. Require your child to put in the hours at home so they come prepared and confident to class.
