How long will my child need to stay?

All students will be expected to stay for the entire concert in order to complete a listening assignment of the other groups performing. This will count as half of their concert participation score.

What is the dress code?

5th and 6th grade will wear white dress tops (boys need a button up shirt) and black dress bottoms with black dress shoes.

7th and 8th grade will wear ALL BLACK with black dress shoes. Boys need a black button up shirt. Girls need long skirts or dress pants. Leggings/yoga pants are NOT acceptable.

How will I help at home?

Our musicians need to learn their music at home. Rehearsals are used for learning everything that's happening around them. We cannot use rehearsal time to only figure out individual parts. Require your child to put in the hours at home so they come prepared and confident to class.

Dismissal Improvements

Those of you picking up at the end of the day may have noticed an increase in the efficiency of our pick up procedure now that we have worked out the kinks of the new Silent Dismissal system. Parents now know that dismissal is usually finished by 3:10. Thank you Ms. Kaiser and Mrs. Severson for your efficiency!

Now we need to address the **safety issue** that continues to be a problem at the front of the school. Parents parking at Aldi and walking across the parking lot at 3:00 and after are creating a dangerous situation. The hedges at the side of the school can obscure people from being seen by cars and drivers often need to stop quite suddenly as students and parents don't always wait for a break in traffic. It is for this reason that we are <u>again</u> requesting that parents stay in their cars for back pick up unless

they have a meeting with a teacher or other reason to be in the school at the end of the day. We do not have a spacious area for parents to wait and, in addition to the traffic issue it creates outside, there is congestion at the front door of the school as kids are exiting for the buses as well.
